Results: Swabbed in pits 12 hours, and 3 hours in tanks as follows: 1st hour 12.00 barrels; 2nd hour 9.52 barrels; 3rd hour 1.36 barrels. Total 22.88 barrels. 20% BS&W. 250# Casing Pressure this AM.
