Ran Gamma Ray Neutron Log. Squeeze perfs at 3660' to 3727' and open hole from 3750' to 3858' with 250 sx. Reg. cement. Re-squeeze with 250 sx. RN. Drill out cement to 3742'. Perforate 7" O.D. Casing 3702' to 3714', 3730' to 3742' with 2 jet shots per ft. Acidize perfs with 2000 gals LST NHA. Frac 7" O.D. Casing perfs with 10,000 gals Ref. oil and 1500 lbs. sand. Swab well, recover load oil, test, and return well to production. On 24 hr. PT ending 10:00 A.M. 5-28-61 well flowed @ BO and no water thru 26/64" choke. Gravity 29.5, GOR 5975 Top of Pay 3702', Btm of Pay 2742'.
