FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We request permission to use a central tank battery and treating plant to receive the production from the following wells: State of N. M. "H" (Lieu Land: Lease No. 54036) Wells Nos. 7, 11, 12, 16, 20, 22, 23, and one additional well which may be drilled and completed at a later date. All of these wells are located on Lieu Land.

The central tank battery and treating plant would, therefore, eventually be used to receive the production from seven or possibly eight wells located in the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 20, T-20-S, R-37-E, and would be located approximately as shown on the attached sketch. It would include adequate tankage and other equipment, so that the production from each well could be accurately determined at reasonable intervals.
