Reference is made to your application of August 24, 1954, pertaining to the approval of a dual completion of the above captioned well.

This Commission cannot approve your dual completion as outlined on your application due to the fact that there is an obvious error in the formation names on the application.

You will note that in paragraph (C) (3) that you refer to the lower Seven Rivers oil zone being produced through the tubing and Queen Sands gas through the tubing-casing annulus. The Queen Gas Sands are located geologically below the Seven Rivers formation.

We would also like to call your attention to the fact that this Commission by virtue of Order R-520, established the Eumont Gas Pool as producing from the Yates-Seven Rivers and Queen. The underlying Eunice-Monument Oil Pool is now described as producing from the Grayburg-San Andres formation. It is entirely possible that your application should have referred to the Queen formation as the gas bearing formation and the Grayburg-San Andres as the oil bearing formation.

Please examine the completion data on this well and if necessary re-submit your application.
