Grayburg on September 10, 1954 recovered 5.50 BO, 89 BM and 445 MCF through a 16/64ⁿ choke for a GOR of 80,909. Flowing tubing pressure was 100 psig.

The above data indicates no communication between the Yates, Seven Rivers, Queen and Grayburg pays.

Also attached is a diagrammatic sketch of the mechanical installation which was actually installed and used to segregate production from the Queen production zones.
