Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the W/2 of the W/2 Section 33, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the Bell-Ramsay - State "B" Lease, a portion of which is above described.
- (2) The Bell-Ramsay - State "B" #2 located 660 feet from the West and South lines of Section 33, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed July 2, 1937, at a depth of 3840 feet in the Eumont Oil Pool; and an application to dually complete this well in the Eumont Gas Pool was filed with the Oil Conservation Commission on June 1, 1955. The applicant proposes to use this well as the Unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
