Ran 5 1/2" casing set at 3799' using 17 centralizers, 23 scratchers and 1510 sacks incor sulphate cement, 1 to 1 Diamix. Plug down at 9 P.M. 8-8-56. Tested 5 1/2" casing with 1,000' pressure before and after drilling plug. No pressure drop. Temperature survey showed top of cement to be at 1390'.
