Gentlemen:

John M. Kelly respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to Order R-553, No Flare Order, as it pertains to John M. Kelly's State C #1, Section 36, T-20-S, R-37-E, Eumont Pool, and in support thereof, states the following facts:

The State C #1 is located 1900 feet from the North and West lines of Section 36, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and was completed on December 10, 1956, as an oil well in the Hardy Pool. The well produces at a rate of 46 BOPD and 304 MCF of gas per day or a gas oil ratio of 6600 cubic feet per barrel.

Attached hereto is a plat indicating, well location, offset ownership, and location of tank battery. The nearest gas connection is on the Continental Oil State A-36 Lease approximately 2500 feet distance, a Continental Carbon Line. Continental Carbon Company advised us that they would connect the State "C" Lease about April 1, 1957.

In view of the foregoing, it is requested that the Oil Conservation Commission issue a temporary exception to its Order R-553, for the State C #1. We will inform you by means of a form C-110 when a casing head gas connection is obtained for this well.
