Gentlemen:

Stanolind Oil and Gas Company hereby files application to dually complete O. J. Gullully "B" No. 4 at an unorthodox location of 240' from the north and west lines of Section 22, T-20-S, R-37-E.

The well is presently producing from the Grayburg in the Monument Field from the interval 3736' to 3874'. Applicant plans to perforate the Yates, Seven Rivers and Queen sections at various intervals from approximately 2600' to 3600' and dually complete. A packer will be employed to segregate the Grayburg oil and Yates, Seven Rivers and Queen gas.

As required by Rule 112-1, the following are attached:

- (1) A plat showing the location of all wells on applicant's lease, and all offset wells on offset lease.
- (2) A sketch showing the manner and method of applicant's proposed dual completion.
