M., on October 16, 1959, due to its inability to produce minimum contract requirements. The well was not produced into the suction of the compressors until April 14, 1960, as Continental Oil Company was using the well for lift purposes. By letter dated April 21, 1959, they had requested 21 Paso Natural Gas Company to discontinue purchases from the well until notified by them. On April 14, 1960, notification was received from Faul Jacobs of Continental Oil Company, and the well was turned on.
