The Continental Oil Company's Semu Eumont #68 well was switched from the Jal High Pressure Gathering System to the suction of the West Eunice Compressors at 1:00 P. M., on October 16, 1959, due to its inability to produce minimum contract requirements. The well was not produced into the suction of the compressors until April 14, 1960, as Continental Oil Company was using the well for lift purposes. By letter dated April 21, 1959, they had requested El Paso Natural Gas Company to discontinue purchases from the well until notified by them. On April 14, 1960, notification was received from Paul Jacobs of Continental Oil Company, and the well was turned on.
