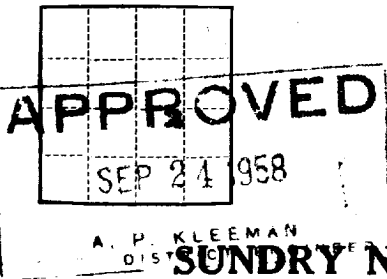

**DETAILS OF WORK**

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to a total depth of 3750' with rotary tools in order to continue the development of the Euzont Gas reserves and meet the demands of the U.S.G.S. for further development of federal leases comprising the Southeast Monument Unit. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U.S.G.S. and any other special requirements will be met and complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern: 6-5/8" to be set at 300' and cemented with approximately 250 sacks, cement to be circulated. 5-1/2" to be set at 3750' with 1150 sacks and perforated opposite pay zones. Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
