New C-102 for SEMU Tubb No. 7 Unit F, Sec. 23, T-20S, R-37E Recompleted to Monument Tubb Pool

Your letter of July 11, 1991 requested a new C-102 for this well reflecting its recompletion to the Monument Tubb Pool. Your suggested orientation for the 80-acre proration unit (a lay-down unit in the S/2 NW/4 Sec. 23) immediately triggered a red flag. This orientation would put 40 acres within the existing Tubb Participating Area and 40 acres outside of it.

Referring to the attached map you can see that this problem was created when the proration unit was established for the SEMU Tubb No. 122 in 1989. As you can see, all of the other Tubb proration units have been stand-up units and completely within or outside the participating area.

Can we simply redesignate the W/2 NW/4 as the 80-acre unit for well No. 122 and then allocate the E/2 NW/4 to the new SEMU Tubb No. 7 recompletion?

I have included new C-102's for both of these wells under the assumption that this will solve the problem. If anything further is required, please call me at (915) 686-6548. Thank you.
