INSTRUCTIONS

This report shall be filed in duplicate with the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, covering each unit from which oil or gas is produced. A separate report shall be filed for each transporter authorized to transport oil or gas. After sale certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, a copy shall be forwarded to the transporter, one copy retained by the transporter and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A separate report shall be filed to cover each change in operating ownership and each change in the estimated allowable production for one operation period. The operator of the unit shall notify the Oil Conservation Commission District Office of the transporter authorized by certificate on file with the Commission, bearing the estimated amount of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter for each operation period from the unit and the name of such temporary transporter and to sign such notice shall also be furnished such temporary transporter. Said temporary transporter shall not move any more oil or gas than the estimated amount as indicated on notice.

This certificate shall be executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission and shall be a permit for pipe line connection and authorization to transport oil or gas from the unit named therein and shall remain in full force and effect until cancelled.

If any of the above mentioned of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been completed within the time this report is filed, explain fully under the heading "REMARKS".

In all cases where this report is filed to cover a change in operating ownership or a change in the transporter designated to move oil or gas, show under "REMARKS" a copy of the certificate of the operator and the transporter previously authorized to transport oil or gas.

A separate report shall be filed to cover each producing unit as designated by the Oil Conservation Commission.
