DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to a total depth of approximately 3725' with rotary tools in order to develop the high pressure "Queen" gas reserves and to meet demands of the U. S. G. S. for Eminent Pool gas development and to prevent drainage by existing and anticipated offset wells. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern: 8 5/8" to be set at 3275' and cemented with approximately 500 sacks cement to be circulated. 5 1/2" to be set at 3725' and cemented with approximately 1200 sacks, and to be perforated opposite the pay zone.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
