Gentlemen:

This letter will confirm telephone conversation on January 14, 1955, between Messrs. R. E. L. Batts and J. D. Walker of Gulf and Mr. W. B. Macey of the Oil Conservation Commission.

Your Administrative Order NSP-56, dated January 7, 1955, ascribed to our Bell-Ramsay "B" Well #1, the S/2 of the S/2, Section 29, T-20-S, R-37-E. We had previously dedicated to this well for proration purposes the SW/4 Section 29, T-20-S, R-37-E, and your Order NSP-56, when made effective, will automatically result in the dissolution of the previously established gas proration unit which contains 80 acres of our Amos B. Reeves Lease and 80 acres of our Bell-Ramsay State Lease. We had contemplated that the 80 acres of the Amos B. Reeves Lease would be reassigned and included in our proposed 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the S/2 N/2 and the N/2 S/2 Section 29, T-20-S, R-37-E; however since you have turned down our application for such 320-acre unit, we are requesting that you delay making Administrative Order NSP-56 effective pending our providing a well to which the Reeves Lease acreage can be assigned.

We propose to immediately file an application for authorisation to dually complete our Amos B. Reeves Lease Well #1 which is located 660 feet from the West line and 1980 feet from the South line Section 29, T-20-S, R-37-E, and also apply for a non-standard 160-acre unit comprising the N/2 S/2 Section 29 and utilizing the dually completed Amos B. Reeves #1 as the proposed unit well.
