Re: Application for 160-acre Non-standard
Gas Proration Unit, Eumont Gas Pool,
Comprising the N/2 of the S/2 of
Section 29, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County,
New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprised of the N/2 of the S/2 of Section 29, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the Amos B. Reeves Lease, a portion of which comprises the 160 acres above described, and is shown on attached Exhibit "A".
- (2) The Amos B. Reeves Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the west line, Section 29, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was originally completed July 2, 1936, as an oil well in the Eunice Oil Pool. Application is now being made to dually complete this well as a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 (b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
