Gentlemen:

Fulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas provation unit comprised of the N/2 of the S/2 of Section 27, T-20-S, R-37-E. Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- Fall Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of an oil and gus lease known as the Amos B. Reeves Lease, a portion of which comprises the 160 acres above described, and is shown on attached Exhibit "A".
- (2) The arcs B. Reeves Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the west line, Section 29, I-RO-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was originally completed July 2, 1936, as an oil well in the Eunice Cil Pool. Application is now being made to dually complete his well as a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas promation unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 (b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous parter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (t) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single covernments section.
 - (c) All acrease within the proposed unit may reasonably to presumed to be productive of gas.
