Gentlemen:

On December 1, 1954, Gulf Oil Corporation made written application for an exception to the Conservation Commission's Order R-520 in regard to the creation of a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool to be located in Section 29, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. By your letter of January 11, 1955, you informed Gulf that according to Rule 5 (a) paragraph 3 of Order R-520 the maximum acreage that could be assigned to our Amos E. Reeves Lease Well No. 2 is 160 acres because of the well's location in respect to the north and west boundaries.

Therefore, Gulf Oil Corporation hereby resubmits its application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the S/2 of the N/2, Section 29, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the Amos E. Reeves Lease, a portion of which comprises the 160 acres above described.
- (2) The Amos E. Reeves No. 2 located 1980 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the west line, Section 29, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was originally completed on July 20, 1937, as an oil well in the Eunice Monument Pool. This well has been plugged back from a total depth of 3840 feet to a depth of 3634 feet and on November 26, 1954, was recompleted as a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
