Gas Proration Unit, Eminent Gas Pool,
Comprising S/2 of N/2 and N/2 of S/2,

Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the S/2 of N/2 and N/2 of S/2, Section 29, T20S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the Amos B. Reeves Lease which comprises the 320 acres above described.
- (2) The Amos B. Reeves #2 located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line, Section 29, T20S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, was originally completed on July 20, 1937, as an oil well in the Eminent-Monument Pool. This well has been plugged back from a total depth of 3840 feet to a depth of 3634 feet and on November 26, 1954, was re-completed as a gas well in the Eminent Gas Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
