Additional information:

This well was drilled to the Total depth of 3835'. Brown sandy lime. Ran 2 1/2" upset tubing to 3829'. Swabbed in and flowed 25 barrels oil by heads on 4 hour test, thru 1" open choke. Acidized w/ 2000 gallons of Dowell XX acid. Acid started in under u 700# on tubing and 1000# on casing. Dropped to Vacuum. 22 barrels of flush oil went in under Vacuum. Set 6 hours. Ran swab twice and well started flowing. Flowed 502 barrels of pipe line oil on 6 hour test. Through 2 1/2" tubing and 45/64" Choke. Hourly average of 83 barrels. Daily gas rate of 840,000. Gas oil ratio 421. Tubing pressure 240#.
