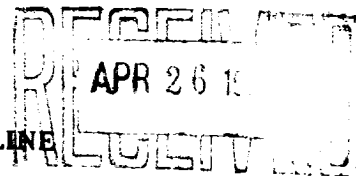

Additional information:

This well was drilled to the total depth of 3620'. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " upset tubing was set at 3620' with packer set at 3755'. Well was acidized 4 times with the total of 10,000 gallons of acid. The well then flowed 94.5 barrels pipe line oil on 7 hour test, through 1" open choke on 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " tubing.
