Dear Sir:

Gulf Oil Corporation is the Operator of a non-standard gas promotion unit consisting of the SE/4 of Section 30, Township 20 North, Range 27 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Hurant Gas Pool. The unit well is Gulf Oil Corporation's Sunshine Well No. 2 located in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 30. An application for the approval of this non-standard gas promotion unit was filed, and by your Administrative Order No. 1 P 172, you approved the formation of the unit and provided for an allowable in accordance with the pool rules based upon a unit of 160 acres.

Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner of the leasehold interest covering Lot 4 in the E/2 SE/4 of Section 30 and Sinclair Oil and Gas Company is the owner of the leasehold interest covering Lot 2 of Section 30. Gulf and Sinclair have agreed to pool their respective interests for the production of gas from this unit within the limits of the Hurant Gas Pool and the Pooling Agreement is in the process of preparation for execution.

Pursuant to the practice heretofore followed by the Commission, you are requested to place the unit well upon the gas promotion schedule, effective immediately, allocating to it an allowable based upon the 160 acre unit in the Hurant Gas Pool.
