Dear Sir:

Gulf Oil Corporation is the operator of a non-standard gas production unit consisting of the S $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Block 20 South, Range 27 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Turment Gas pool. The unit well is Gulf Oil Corporation's Sunshine well "a." located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30. An application for the approval of this non-standard gas production unit was filed, and by your Administrative Order No. 1 P 172, you approved the formation of the unit and provided it is allowable in accordance with the pool rules based upon a unit of 160 acres.

Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner of the leased oil interest covering Lot 2 in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30 and Sinclair Oil and Gas Company is the owner of the leasehold interest covering Lot 3 of Section 30. Gulf and Sinclair have agreed to pool their respective interests for the production of gas from this unit within the limits of the Turment Gas pool and the pooling Agreement is in the process of preparation for execution.

According to the practice heretofore followed by the Commission, you are requested to place the unit well upon the gas production schedule, effective immediately, allotting to it an allowable based upon the 160 acre unit in the Turment Gas pool.
