INSTRUCTIONS

This certificate is to be filled out and filed in QUADRUPLICATE with the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, covering each unit from which oil or gas is produced. A duplicate shall be filed for each transporter authorized to transport from the unit. After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, one copy shall be forwarded to the transporter, one copy retained by the Commission, and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operating ownership and each change in transporter, except that in the case of a temporary change in the transporter, the transporter shall file the allowable production for one proration period. The operator, in filing a new certificate, notify the Oil Conservation Commission by letter of the name of the transporter authorized by certificate on file with the Commission, the date of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter, the name of the unit from which oil or gas is to be moved, and the name of such temporary transporter. A copy of such notice shall also be furnished such temporary transporter. Such temporary transporter shall not move any more oil or gas than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

This certificate when properly executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall constitute a permit for pipe line connection and authorization to transport oil and gas from the property named therein and shall remain in full force and effect until:

- (1) Changing ownership changes
- (2) The transporter is changed or
- (3) The permit is cancelled by the Commission.
