## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 3817: Dumped 100 quarts SNG 3770-90. Gravel tamp to 3754, eight sacks Calseal to 3716. Double acting AG bomb detonated at 11:32. Calseal plug did not hold. Hole filled with 225' rotary mud. Bailed 25 bailers and exhausted. From March 25 to May 21 repaired clean out machine and cleaned out hole to original total depth of 2817. Ran tubing and started pumping. Average daily production 7 barrels oil and 7 barrels water.
