T. D. 3850 Lime. Pulled tubing & rods, ran Schlumberger Dale Survey, found water production was from 3828' to 3840'. Plugged back with 7 sacks cement to 3817'. Ran tubing & rods with tubing set 3804'. May 14, 1940, pumped 50 bbls. oil and 50 bbls. water in 24 hours. May 21, 1940, pumped 63 bbls. oil and 22 bbls. water in 24 hours. May 31st, 1940, pumped 50 bbls. oil and 10 bbls. water in 24 hours.
