DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 3850 in lime. Treated pay formations from 3724 to 3850 with 5000 gallons Dowell "XX" solution through tubing.

Started swabbing 3 hours after treating. Recovered 189 barrels oil load and acid in 10 hours. Next day swabbed 14 hours. 192 barrels mostly oil load. Shut in over night. Opened next morning. Would not flow. Swabbed 48 bbl. oil, no water, in 6 hours through tubing.
