DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 3850 in lime. Loaded hole with oil and treated with 1000 gallons Dowell "XX" through tubing. Started swabbing 1 hour after treatment. Swabbed out 96 barrels oil load in 8 1/2 hours. Shut down over night. Opened next morning failed to flow. Swabbed 12 hours. 195 barrels oil. Would not flow next morning after being shut in over night. Casing pressure 420#. Swabbed 9 hours recovering approximately 85 barrels oil.
