Total depth 3850 in lime. Treated with 3000 gallons Dowell "XX" from 3725 to 3850.

Started swabbing 2 hours after treating. Recovered 90 bbl oil load & shut in over night. Would not flow next morning. Swabbed dry recovering 145 bbl oil load & shut in over night. 580# pressure on casing following morning. Would not flow. Shut in over night. Ran swab once next day & flowed 43 bbl. oil, no water, one head flow. Shut in. Opened again next morning & flowed 43 bbl oil in one head flow.
