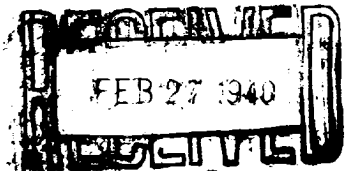

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Treated well with 3,000 gallons of Halliburton acid in lime formation from 3750' to 3840'. Swabbed well in - started flowing by heads. Started flowing steady cleaning out oil load & acid sludge and died. Rocked well off without swabbing - well cleaned itself. Flowed 54 bbls. oil in 24 hours through 1/2" choke. Gas-oil ratio 1566.
