Total Depth 3868' - Lime. 7" casing cemented at 3740'.

This well was completed in November, 1936, with IP of 12 barrels per hour flowing. The oil and gas production has declined to the point where the well barely makes its allowable and flows by heads.

We desire permission to acidize this well from approximately 3740' to 3860' with 4,000 gallons in an effort to increase the oil production and make the well flow steady.
