 Total depth, 3855' - Lime. 7" casing cemented at 3737' with 275 sacks.
 Completed 4-12-37.

The production from this well had declined to the extent that well would not make top allowable. A packer was set at 3810' and the section from 3810 to 3855' acidized in three stages of 1000 gals, 2000 gals, & 4000 gals, respectively. After third stage on 3-4-44 well flowed 11 barrels of oil in 11 hours. Pumping equipment was installed, and on 7-5-44 well produced 22 barrels oil plus 3 barrels water in 24 hours pumping.
