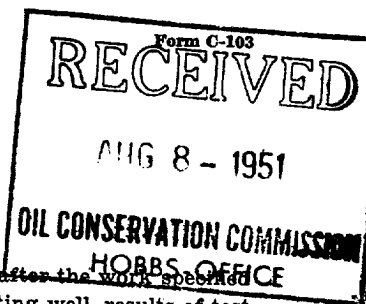

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After a 24 hour shut-in period a back pressure test was conducted using a dead weight pressure gage and 2" critical flow prover. Wellhead casing pressures were used to eliminate the calculation of friction in the producing string. The resulting ABSOLUTE OPEN FLOW WAS 8,800 MCF per 24 HOURS with a 54° slope back pressure curve as measured from the abscissa.
