DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After a 24 hour shut-in period, this well had a shut-in casing pressure of 1037 PSIA; as measured with a dead weight pressure gage. Based on a back pressure test conducted 7-26-51 which had an absolute open flow of 14,700 MCF per day, a shut-in casing pressure of 1048 PSIA, and a θ of 56.5°, (θ measured from horizontal); the calculated ABSOLUTE OPEN FLOW IS 14,500 MCF PER 24 HOURS.
