DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After a 24 hour shut-in period the tubing pressure was 1035 psia as measured by a dead weight pressure gage. Based on a back pressure test conducted on 6-28-50, which indicated an absolute open flow of 7,900 MCF per 24 hours with a shut-in tubing pressure of 1084 psia and a 32° slope back pressure curve, THE CALCULATED ABSOLUTE OPEN FLOW IS 7450 MCF PER 24 HOURS.
