DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A 2" critical flow prover and a dead weight tester were used to obtain the data for this test. After 24 hours shut-in the tubing pressure was 1071 psig. The 4 back pressure flows taken indicated an absolute open flow of 7,900 MCF per 24 hours. The resulting pressure curve had a slope of 30°
