Gentlemen:

Texas Pacific Oil Company respectfully requests administrative
approval under provisions of Rule 5(c) of Order No. 1670 for
the formation of an 80 acre non-standard proration unit for
its Salkey, well No. 2, a klineb y gas well, located 660 feet
EAL and 660 feet NAL of Section 25, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lee County,
New Mexico.

In support of this request the following facts are presented:

1. The proposed non-standard unit consists of the NW $\frac{1}{2}$ of the
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 25, T-21-S, R-37-E and is comprised of
two 40 acre units now authorized by NRP-644 for Salkey,
well No. 1 and NRP-645 for Salkey, well No. 2. Texas
proposes to abolish these two units in order to
form a single 80 acre unit for Well No. 2 and disconnect
Well No. 1.
2. The proposed unit can be operated more economically than
two separate units due to the elimination of an ext r meter
run and the switching of two wells whereas Well No. 2 is
capable of producing the allowable for an 80 acre unit.

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
