Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, the R. Olsen Oil Company wishes to state the following:

(a) That the R. Olsen Oil Company's Eva Owen #1, located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 25, T 21S, R 37E, was completed November 7, 1949, at a total depth of 6579'. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of this well on the R. Olsen Oil Company Owen lease together with the location of offset wells.

(b) The subject well has 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing set at 6400' and cemented with 550 sacks of cement. The well is an oil well producing from the Drinkard Pool from open hole 6400' to 6579'.

(c) The applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:

(1) Perforate the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing within the approximate interval 5560' to 5700' in the Blinebry Gas Pool.

(2) Set a production type packer at approximately 6300' to separate the Drinkard oil zone from the Blinebry gas zone.

(3) Produce the Drinkard oil through the tubing and the Blinebry pool gas through the tubing-casing annulus.

(d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Blinebry pool and oil from the Drinkard pool is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

(e) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.

(f) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.

(g) That by copy of this letter of application, all offset operators are notified of the proposed dual completion.

Therefore, R. Olsen Oil Company requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant permission to the applicant to dually complete the subject well as proposed in this application.

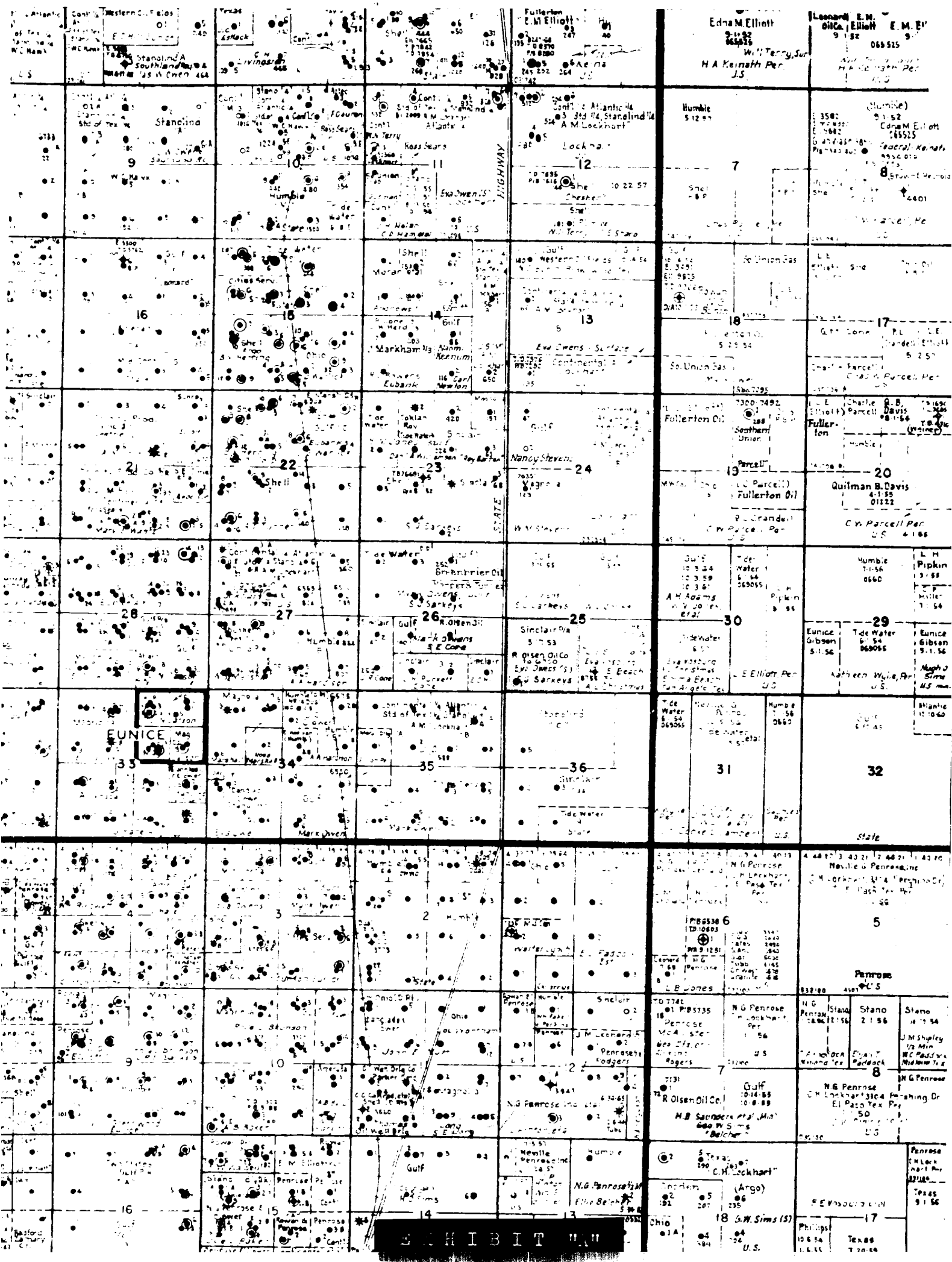


EXHIBIT MAP
