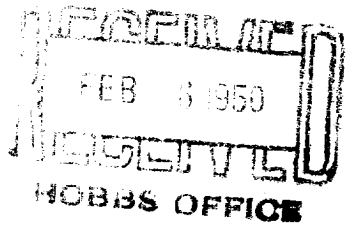

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On Feb 4, 1950. 6450 ft. of 5 1/2" 15 lb casing was run and cemented with ⁷⁰⁰ 900 lbs. of cement. The plug was pumped to bottom and the casing was tested with 1000 #s pressure. No pressure decline was noted and everything was found to be O.K.
