Texas Pacific Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval to triple complete the captioned well in the Drinkard oil, Blinbry oil and the Tubbs gas.

This completion will utilize two strings of tubing for the oil zones and the gas zone will be produced from the annulus. This well has been producing from the Tubbs gas and has a GOR of 258,333:1 with a fluid production of only 3 barrels per day. It is, therefore, felt that an annulus completion for the Tubbs gas would be efficient in keeping the hole clean. The offset Tubbs gas wells also have high GOR's.
