Sinclair Oil & Gas Company wishes to make this application for administrative approval under Order R-316, Rule 112A, to dually complete their J. R. Cone "A" Well No. 2 in the Blinebry Gas Pool and the Drinkard Oil Pool (present zone).

Sinclair also wishes to make application for administrative approval under Order R-610 for a Nonstandard Proration Unit consisting of 80 acres and located in the W/2 of the SW/4 of Section 26-21S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico to be assigned to subject well.

In the above matters Sinclair wishes to state:

- 1. Sinclair Oil & Gas Company is the operator of the J. R. Cone "A" No. 2 Well which is located in the center of the <u>NW/L of the SW/L</u> of Section 26-21S-37E. This well was completed as an oil well in the Drinkard Oil Pool on May 20, 1947, at a total depth of 6,565 feet. Seven inch casing was set at 6553 feet and cemented with 400 sacks and perforated in the Drinkard Oil zone from 6404 to 6414 and from 6475 to 6550 feet.
- 2. Sinclair proposes to dually complete subject well in the following manner:
 - a. Perforate the 7" casing from approximately 5500 feet to 5700 feet in the Blinebry Gas Pool.
 - b. Set a production packer below the Blinebry perforations at about 6300 feet to separate the two pay zones.
 - c. Produce the Blinebry gas through the casing-tubing annulus and the Drinkard oil through the tubing.
