DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The open hole section (Drinkard) from 6515' - 86' was dolofracted with 3000 gals. After cleaning up, the Drinkard averaged flowing 23 BOPD. Tubing was pulled and a Baker Model "D" Retainer Production Packer (see attached diagram) was set at 6138', and the hole above the packer was loaded with salt water. The Tubb zone was opened from 6135 - 6235'. The Tubb zone was acidized with 4000 gals. Regular Acid. Communication tests indicated no leakage between Tubb and Drinkard zones.

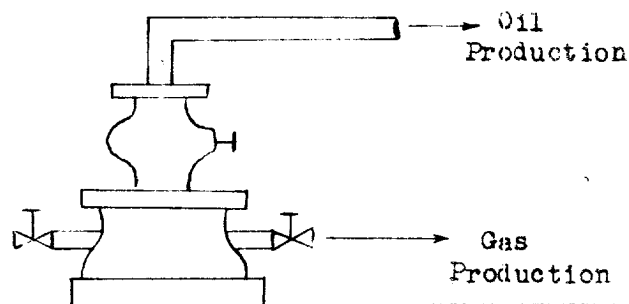
