DETAILS OF WORK

To substantiate Form 9-331a dated 12-6-50 filed in the name of A. M. Lockhart A-27 No. 2-E, wherein it was proposed to redesignate A. M. Lockhart A-27 No. 1-3 to A. M. Lockhart A-27 No. 2-E, as a result of change in producing sections.

The 5 1/2" casing in the subject well was perforated from 7456 to 7474 and was acidized with a total of 3,750 gallons of acid in an attempt to obtain commercial production from the Connell sand. The well was then deepened to the Ellenburger where it was completed for an initial potential of 572 barrels oil per day and redesignated as Lockhart A-27 well No. 2-E.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
