DETAILS OF WORK

This refers to plugging back and testing of Lockhart A-27 No. 2-E.

It is proposed to plug back Lockhart A-27 No. 2-E, presently producing from the Ellenburger formation, by placing a wire line bridging plug at approximately 7595' with a 10' cement cap on top. The well will then be perforated 7466 to 7490 and 7506 to 7524, opposite the Cornell sand, which drill-stem tested 37 barrels oil in one hour at the time the well was drilled. This interval will be acidized if necessary and tested to determine whether or not commercial production is present.

The above is in accordance with telephone conversation on 11-8-50 between Mr. E. L. Shafer, Mr. E. Canfield and Mr. M. H. Soyster.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
