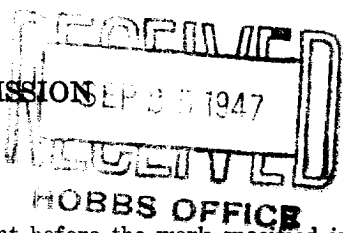

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off at 3:30 PM September 21, 1947.
