**FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK**

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

(This old well (originally Two States & Southern Exploration's Marshall #2) is located 660' South & 1980' West, Sec. 27, T 21-S, R 37-E).

This well has been producing from Penrose-Skelly formation since March 31, 1940 until some time previous to our acquisition of this lease, subsequent to our discovery well in the Drinkard Zone in December 1946. Initial Production was 50 BO/Day after shot W/400 qts. Top Pay was 3676' and T.D. was 3738'.

Following is record of casing in well:

10-3/4" set @ 135', cemented W/200 sacks.  
 7" set @ 3540', cemented W/300 sacks.

It is the Ohio Oil Company's intention drill this well deeper to test the Paddock Zone. Will case off old pay zone from 3676' to 3738'. Rotary tools will be used from 3738' to Approximately 5200'. Approximately 1600' of 5" extreme line will be set above the casing seat with 5-1/2" OD cemented to surface.
