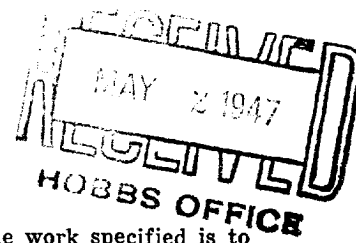

## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On April 29, 1947, the 7" OD 23# 8 RT SS casing (21 jts. A. O. Smith HY, 55 jts. National J-55 short thread, and 116 jts. National J-55 long thread) was set at 6477' line. Cemented with 575 sacks 2% and 125 sacks Neat Bulk cement by Halliburton method. Plug pumped to 6431'. Job started at 7:00 AM and completed at 4:30 PM April 29, 1947.

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off at 4:30 PM May 1, 1947.
