## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On July 14, 1950, loaded hole with 168 barrels of oil and acidized with 1000 gallons by Chemical Process. Injection time 18 minutes, duration 48 minutes. CP - 2150#, TP - 1850#. Flushed with 23 barrels of oil and swabbed 30 barrels load oil in 1½ hours. Flowed 161 barrels load oil in 7 hours, then 182 barrels above load in 8 hours, 20/64" choke. CP - 1000#, TP - 400#, gas - 426,110 cubic feet.
