Tallies 5317', H-13', set @ 5330'. Cemented w/350 sacks 2% HOWCO gel and 150 sacks of common Portland bulk cement. Plug @ 5300'. Job started @ 12:30 p.m., and completed @ 7:45 p.m.

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off @ 7:45 p.m., May 18, 1949.
